

OB ED PROVIDER QUICK TIP

Target Audience: OB ED PROVIDERS

On **July 1st, 2026**, DUHS is launching a new **OB Emergency Department (OB ED)**. FERN and Wet Prep POCT tests will require providers to place their own orders and document results. There are also new note templates and SmartList options available. This document reviews the changes OB ED Providers will see in their workflow.

PLACE POINT OF CARE TEST ORDER

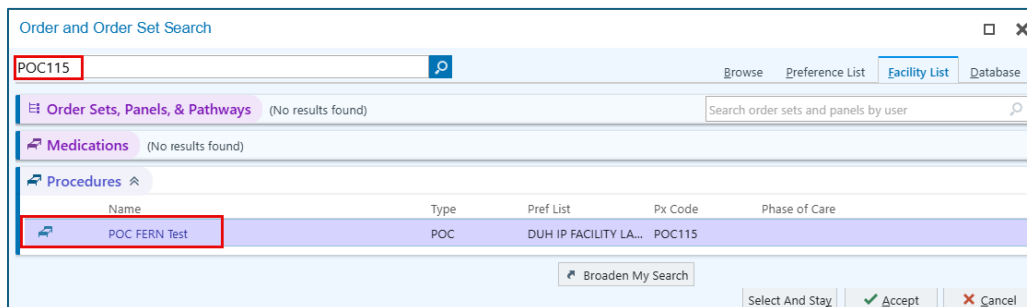
Starting July 1st, you will need to **enter and document results** for your **own orders** for **Fern and Wet Prep Point of Care Tests**.

To **place an order** for POC FERN Test (POC115) or Wet Prep (POC6007):

- **Search** for the appropriate order(s) (POC115 or POC6007) in the Search field on your Visit Taskbar.

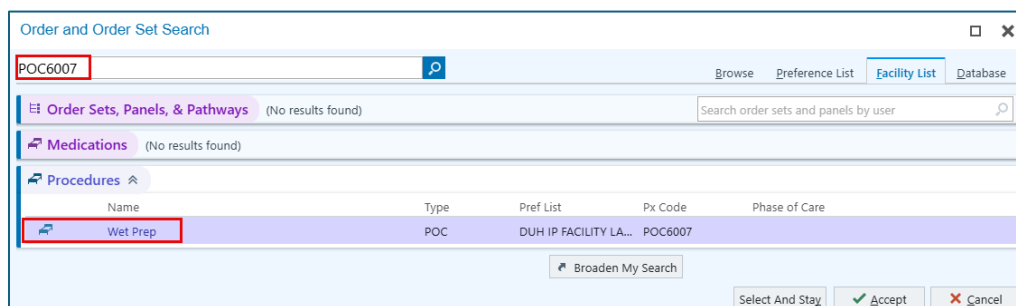

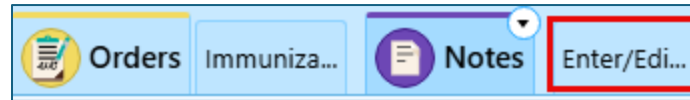

- Once you have the appropriate order(s) selected, **sign** as you would normally.

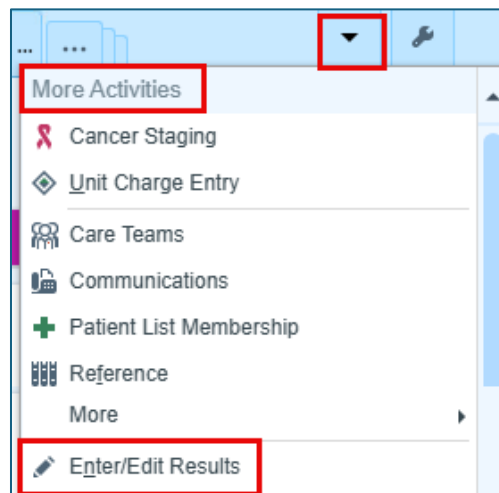
DOCUMENT POINT OF CARE TEST RESULTS

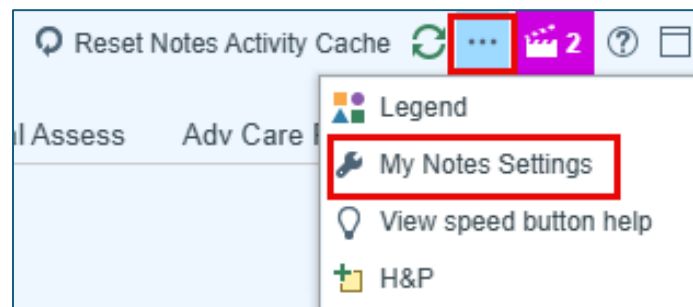

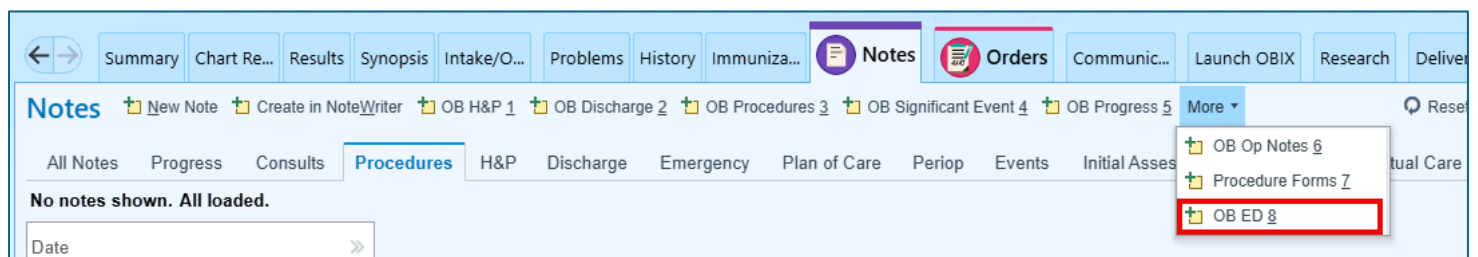
NOTES ACTIVITY PROCEDURE FORMS AND OB ED CHANGES
